RULES & REGULATIONS

HOURS: Monday – Sunday 10am to Sunset

Maximum Patron Load: 58 Persons

- Outside food and drink only allowed if in shatterproof (non-glass) containers.
- All trash shall be cleaned up and disposed of prior to leaving the pool area.
- No glass containers of any kind allowed in the pool area.
- No running, horseplay, pushing, wrestling, or rough play shall be permitted in or around the pool area.
- No pets shall be allowed inside the fenced pool area.
- No person having an obvious communicable disease, open sores, cuts or lesions, eye ear nose or throat infection, is permitted to use the pool.
- No smoking in or around the pool area.
- No profane or abusive language.
- No tossing trash in anything other than provided receptacles.
- No personal sound systems or video players unless they are battery operated and being used with headphones.
- No misuse or vandalism of pool furniture or property. A violation of this may result in charges and/or fines assessed.
- Children under the age of 16 are not allowed to use the pool without an adult present.
- There will be one keycard per household issued. If lost, there is a \$20 replacement fee. If a second keycard is requested, it includes a \$20 additional card fee.
- Always remember there is no lifeguard on duty.
- Residents are allowed two guests per household, and they must be accompanied by the resident at all times, no exceptions.
- Keycards are not to be loaned out to non-residents for pool use.

A violation of any of the rules may result in the temporary loss of pool privileges. Repeated violations may result in the permanent loss of pool privileges. Performance Management will be overseeing all activity involving the pool on behalf of the HOA. After the initial opening, any needs regarding keycards or pool access will be directed to Marcy at Performance. If there are issues with the upkeep, she will be the point of contact.
